2) And after days six Jesus takes aside Peter and James and John and bears them up into (a) mountain high by themselves alone. And he was transfigured (Gr. "metamorphoo" - "metamorphocize") before them, 3) and the garments of him became being radiating white very, such great (white) a washer (fuller?) upon the earth not is able thus to whiten. 4) And appeared to them Elijah with Moses and they were talking together with Jesus. 5) And having replied Peter says to Jesus, "Rabbi, a good thing it is us to here to be, and let us make three tents, to you one and to Moses one and to Elijah one. 6) For not he was knowing (seeing? understanding?) what he might reply, for "feared out ones" they became. 7) And a cloud became shadowing upon them and a voice became out of the cloud, "This one is my son, the beloved. Hear (pl.) him!" 8) And suddenly having looked around no longer no one they saw, but Jesus alone with them.

9) And when they descended out of the mountain he ordered them in order that to no one what things they saw they should relate, except (if not?) when the Son of Man out of the dead ones he might rise. 10) And the word they held firmly toward themselves inquiring together what is the out-of-the-dead-ones to rise.
